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Based on the quirky and beloved Roald Dahl novel, *Matilda the Musical* is an award winning story about an extraordinary little girl with extraordinary wit, intelligence and imagination. Matilda's unloving and abusive parents fail to understand her, and Matilda finds refuge at the library and in the books she loves to read. Mrs. Phelps, the librarian, enjoys Matilda's visits and enthusiastically encourages Matilda to explore her imagination and tell a story. During her visits to the library, Matilda delights Mrs. Phelps by telling her stories about a beautiful acrobat and her adoring husband, the escapologist.

Unfortunately, life for Matilda is no better at school, where the students face a tyrannical and cruel headmistress, Miss Trunchbull. "The Trunchbull" is a former Olympic Champion in Hammer-Throwing who firmly believes in the school motto: "Bambinatum est Magitum," or "Children are Maggots." She enforces excessive practices of ruling with draconian discipline in order to 'break' the school children into submission.

At school, Matilda finds companionship in her classmates and in her kind teacher, Miss Jennifer Honey. Miss Honey is a loving and well-intended teacher, but she is fragile and unable to stand up to the evil headmistress.

Small, but mighty, Matilda knows she has to stand up against the adults in her world, and in doing so she discovers her own remarkable strength and powers. Throughout the story, Matilda's bravery to stand up for herself and others inspires Miss Honey and her classmates. She shows that even if you are little, you CAN do a lot—even if sometimes you have to be a little be naughty!

**WHO** is Mill House Productions? A non-profit 501(c)3, created in 2017, to support SMMS musicals and to help raise funds with local businesses. All funds raised go directly to support the musical.

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
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
